

MISCELLANEOUS PURPOSES SECTOR 2018/19 OPEN CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

**ONLY FOR NON-PROFIT ORGANISATIONS, PUBLIC BENEFIT TRUSTS
& NON-PROFIT COMPANIES (FORMERLY SECTION 21 COMPANIES)**

The Distributing Agency for Miscellaneous Purposes (MP), in terms of the Lotteries Act, 1997 (No. 57 of 1997, as amended), is once again in the position to consider applications for funding from the proceeds of the National Lottery.

In adjudicating applications, the MP Distributing Agency will focus on the following strategic funding areas, aligned to the National Development Plan (NDP) and Government priorities:

Areas of funding

- Projects that falls within the scope of the priority areas identified by the Minister of Trade and Industry in the Regulations on “Direction for Distribution Agencies in determining the distribution of funds from the National Lottery Distribution Trust Fund”.
- Projects that aim to address emergency situations, disasters and catastrophic events.
- Projects that fall outside the scope of Arts, Culture and National Heritage, Charities and Sport and Recreation sector but within National Priorities.

PLEASE NOTE:

- The potential applicant must show that it aims to improve the quality of life of people and communities who are disadvantaged by poverty or social exclusion;
- They need to indicate that projects undertaken or to be undertaken will promote social inclusion and encourage community involvement;
- The Miscellaneous Purposes is not a replacement of the NLC's other sector allocations;
- The Miscellaneous Purposes will not consider an application if declined by one of the sector Distributing Agencies because the funding criteria were not adhered to;
- The Miscellaneous Purposes will not consider an application which attempts to augment an allocation received from a sector Distributing Agency, where the funding received is less than the amount applied for.

The criteria for a decision to fund or not will be based on the strategic fit of the application submitted. Applications that fall outside the strategic focus detailed above will not be considered.

The Distributing Agency for Miscellaneous Purposes will give preference to applications that advance rural, previously disadvantaged and poorer communities that support transformation and development; as well as projects that focus on job creation and the development of women and the disabled.

Applications will be considered from appropriately registered, non-profit organisations that submit all the required documents and information, as outlined in the **Guidelines** for this sector.

Applicants that are awaiting a response on a previous application are advised not to apply until they have received correspondence on the outcome of the previous application.
