NLC commits million to fight GBV – 16 Days of Activism

Pretoria, 10 December 2018. As the nation closes off the 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence (GBV) campaign for 2018, the NLC is pleased to announce the approval of funding for several projects aimed at fighting the scourge of violence against women and children.

These include the Women Integral Impact Network (WIIN), which has developed an app which will enable victims to access immediate assistance from the police and emergency healthcare, and proactive funding for the Total Shutdown Movement (Soul City Institute).

This funding is in line with the NLC's priority funding areas, under prevention and intervention programmes that address crime reduction, early interventions for gender-based violence, violence against children the elderly and people with disabilities.

On Monday, 10 December representatives from **WIIN, Maake Community Victim and Support Centre, and Akonaho Victim Empowerment Programme** (who applied for funding), and **The Soul City Institute (Total Shutdown Movement)** and **Izimvo 447 NPC/Cheryl Zondi Foundation**
