



## MISCELLANEOUS PURPOSES SECTOR

### 2023/24 CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The Distributing Agency for Miscellaneous Purposes (MPDA) established in terms of the Lotteries Act, 1997 (no. 57 of 1997 as amended) is once again able to consider applications from funding from the proceeds of the National Lottery.

In adjudicating applications, the MPDA will give preference to applications from organisations that respond to social and economic challenges in underdeveloped areas; that advance the interests and participation of women, youth, and people with disabilities; that lead to job creation and retention; and that align to the priorities of government as captured in the NDP and the Economic Reconstruction and Recovery Plan (ERRP). Applicants will also be expected to demonstrate that they have the requisite capacity (i.e., personnel, skills, experience, systems) to manage the programme.

Note further that applicants may only apply for grants under one sector.
