DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED WITH APPLICATION

- i. A copy of the competition rules
- ii. A certified copy of the minutes of the society's governing body's full meeting approving the promotion of lotteries under the scheme.
- iii. A letter or statement from the society's governing body authorising the promoter to act in such a capacity.
- iv. Detailed estimate of individual items of expenditure and a detailed budget for the proposed project to be funded by the proceeds of the lottery.
- v. Draft ticket. It should be noted that all tickets must specify their price, the full name of the society, promoter's name & address, the date and place of the draw and the fact that the society is registered with the National Lotteries Commission.
- vi. A proof of payment made to "National Lotteries Commission", for the fees payable on application for registration of the scheme.
- vii. A personal declaration form (SL2(A)/14), completed by the promoter. The Commission may subsequently require any other person connected with the lotteries to complete such form.

Note: Any modification to the scheme should be approved by the National Lotteries Commission.
