National Lotteries Commission to Celebrate Mandela Day at National Children's Theatre

- Creating 45 youth jobs in the creative arts sector
- Train 18 teachers in arts integration and theatre education
- Feature 50 child actors in Disney's The Lion King JR.

Jodi Scholtz, Commissioner of the NLC, said "As we commemorate Nelson Mandela Day, partnering with the National Children's Theatre reminds us of Madiba's unwavering belief in the power of education and storytelling to shape young minds. Through the arts, we not only celebrate his legacy, but we pass it on to future generations."

In alignment with the day's message, NLC provincial offices across the country will also participate by visiting projects they have funded in their respective provinces, continuing their commitment to fighting

poverty and promoting equitable development.

The NLC calls upon all South Africans to take part in this legacy movement by demonstrating that every act of service, every empowered child, and every uplifted voice contributes to building a better future for all.
